Folks,

Welcome to a new school year and a new school – Bridgetown Regional Community School!

Our staff of 35 teachers and 15 support staff are excited for the school year and working in a building that so well supports the teaching-learning cycle.

A few notes as we get started:

- The kitchen will not be commissioned and open for a few weeks so students need to bring a bag lunch each day.
- The EASIEST place for “drop off/ pick up” of students (and probably most beneficial for those between Grades 6-12) is along the Active Transportation Path that starts behind BRHS. This will alleviate congestion on Cromwell Court leading to BRCS.
- If you do choose to drop your child off at BRCS pull to the right in the school parking lot, drop your child off at the curb along the P-5 wing and then proceed west along Cromwell Court and right onto Fay Road. Please don't use the Bus Loop for regular vehicular traffic, as it is only for busses and is a Fire Lane.
- For the first two days of school, parents of P-5 students may accompany their child to their classroom first thing in the morning, though there will be 25 Student Leaders acting as guides. Regular school protocol of dropping them off in the foyer, will start on Monday September 11th, 2017.
- Students arriving after 8:45 need to be signed in and dropped off at the office, not the classroom. Pick up before dismissal (2:55) also requires sign out and pick up in the office, not the classroom and not by texting the student.
- Though you can't tour BRCS when we are in session, please do attend the BRCS Parent/Student Open House at 6 PM September 14th when tours will be led by students.
