An application form must be completed and accompany the essay.

## ELIGIBILITY:

All Indigenous children/grandchildren (including foster children/grandchildren) of National Union of Public and General Employees' current/retired members who plan to enter the 1<sup>st</sup> year of a Canadian public, post-secondary institution full-time in 2018 / 2019 are eligible to apply.

## AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$1,500. Information provided by the winner will be verified prior to awarding of the scholarship.
